VIRTUAL MEETING FOR ALL PARENTS AND CARERS

As you know, we are planning to re-open the school building on 1st June to our Year 6 children and the children of our critical workers. I know that many of you will have questions about this and will want to know how the school plans to operate over the coming weeks.

In order to answer your questions and give you a detailed understanding of what we plan to do, I will be hosting a virtual presentation to parents on **TUESDAY**, **19**th **MAY** at **6 30pm**. The meeting will be conducted via Zoom, and the details of how to join the meeting are below. Whilst the meeting will primarily deal with the logistics of opening the school to our Year 6 pupils, it is relevant for all parents, as I will also talk about our distance learning provision and what challenges I envisage as we move into July. Please note, there is a limit of 300 people who are able to log on to the Zoom platform.

During the meeting, it will not be possible to answer questions. However, we would like to cover the issues that are most concerning you. If you have a question that you would like answering, please send it to Mrs Brinicombe at deputy@horsell-junior.surrey.sch.uk by 12 00pm on Monday, 18th May. I will then endeavour to cover as many of your queries as I can during my presentation.

Over the next few days, I will be sharing our school policies and procedures with you. As you can appreciate, we are working to tight timescales as government and county advice is coming out almost daily. We are working as hard as we can to get these documents to you in a timely manner. All information about the school re-opening, including slides for Tuesday's presentation, will be posted onto our website in a new folder called 'school re-opening' under the 'news and events' tab. We will also be sending out frequent ParentMail communications so please continue to monitor your emails. Following on from Tuesday's presentation, we will be sending out a parent survey for all of our Year 6 parents to ascertain the likely number of Year 6 pupils we can expect on 1st June.

Thank you for your continuing support and I look forward to sharing our plans with you on Tuesday evening.
