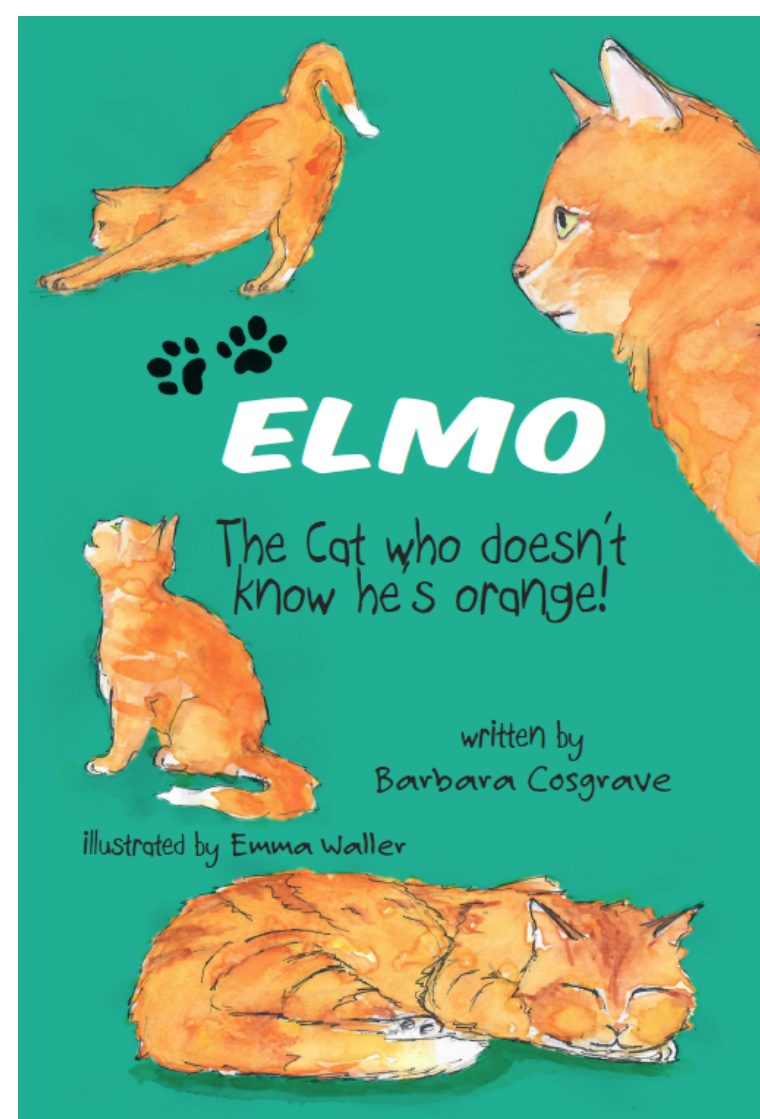
"ELMO THE CAT WHO DOESN'T KNOW HE'S ORANGE!"

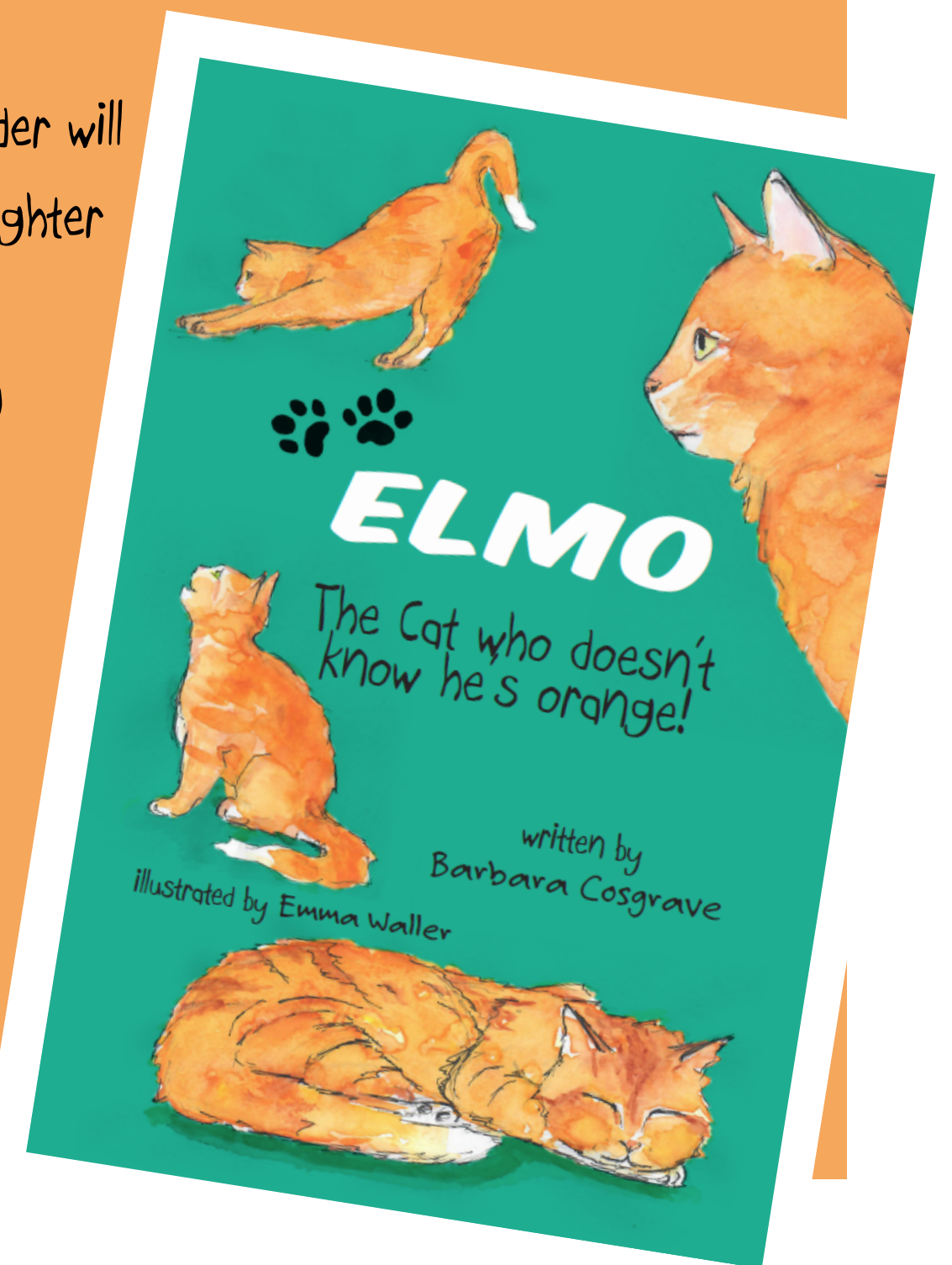
# WHAT DO MY READERS THINK ABOUT ME?
