Homework & Seesaw

Autumn assessments

In November, our whole school will be taking part in assessments for reading, SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and maths using NTS formal assessments. Teachers will also be assessing writing using the independent writing activities the children have already completed over the previous half term. As a school we use this information, along with in class teacher judgements, to map out our future planning, intervention groups and highlight any gaps in knowledge which may need to be taught again.

Teachers and senior leadership (which includes Ms Ash, our Inclusion AHT) meet to discuss all children within our termly 'Pupil Progress Meetings'.

We will let you know how your child has performed through our parents' evening session, and also through our 'Snapshot reports' which will be sent directly to you as parents on Friday 19th November.

Book bands will also change if appropriate, based on these assessments.

Year 4 Topics

Year 4 have had great fun this half term learning about sound in Science. The children were able to take part in range of practical lessons to enthuse their learning. One of the most popular lessons was learning about sound vibrations using water and a tuning fork.

In Year 4, it is a great opportunity for every child to have the opportunity to learn a musical instrument and we are pleased that, this year, we are able to have clarinet lessons again. The children can now piece together their clarinet and have begun to learn how to play two notes. We look forward to observing more lessons and recording pieces of music for you to hear at home.

We are particularly impressed with the quality of the children's writing. They are becoming increasingly confident in using a wide range of vocabulary and using thesauruses to increase independence. We have written three detailed pieces this half term which are around key texts and a short film: The Lost Thing, Pinocchio and Aladdin.

During next half-term, we will be starting our 'Who were the Romans?' topic. This will mainly be our history topic, however we will also be learning about Roman numerals in maths and also writing a holiday brochure in English and Computing.

In maths we will also be learning methods of multiplication and division. It is important that each child in Year 4 is working hard to learn all of their times tables up to 12x12, ready for a timed times table assessment required by the DfE in June.

Please remember that Monday skills sessions are changing after half term. Pine will now be cooking or going to forest school. Acer will start swimming and Palm will be in PE with Mr Coles.
