Dear Parents and Carers,



# Drop Off For Donations for the Ukrainian Refugees

St. Mary's Church porch will be open Monday-Friday 10am-5pm (starting Thursday 3rd March) for your donations. If you have boxes we would be delighted to have these too so we can box the donations up into different categories ready for collection.

The most needed items are:-

Medical Supplies- bandages, plasters, blister plasters, antiseptic wipes, antihistamines, calpol tablets or sachets and above all painkillers (paracetamol, ibuprofen) - the Ukraine is out of painkillers so even the smallest quantity will be most gratefully received;

**Toiletries**- baby wipes , sanitiser wipes, shower gel, toothpaste, shampoo, shaving cream ;

**Food-**energy bars, instant noodles, soup powders, pot noodles, tea/coffee; hot chocolate and canned foods (only those with ring pulls please!)


# **CONGRATULATIONS!**
