This helps them to become better at resolving conflict themselves and develop strategies for settling disagreements.

We have had a successful week of sport at school – our cricket team has progressed to the county finals and our swimmers came third in a swimming gala at Guildford Spectrum on Saturday evening. We are now looking forward to Sports day which is fast approaching!
