### <u>Times Tables</u>

By the end of Year 4 all children should know their times tables up to 12x12.

From Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2023, all Year 4 children will have to sit a timed assessment on an IPAD/Desktop. This test is formed of 25 questions with a time limit of 6 seconds in-between each question.

Please encourage your child/ren to practice their times tables as much as they can to support them with this.

On Times Table Rockstars any practice is good, however, the Soundcheck setting is set up for the 6 second limit which helps children familiarise themselves with the timing.
