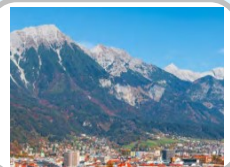
Mont Blanc:

Mont Blanc is the highest mountain in the Alps.



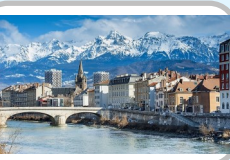
Skiing and hiking

Most of the Alps have a mountain climate



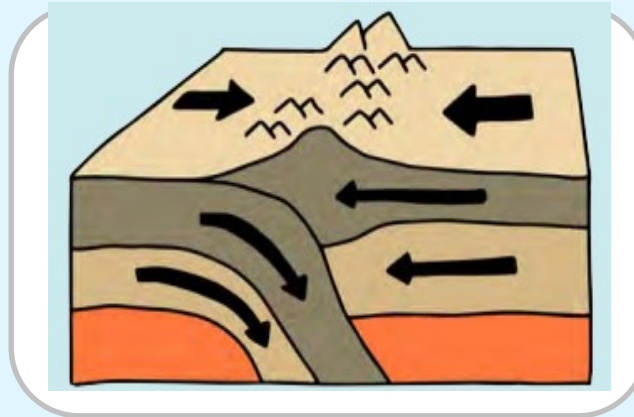
There are more than 14 million people living in the Alps.
