### **KEEPING SAFE AROUND STRANGERS**

On Thursday, the teachers spent some time talking to the children about 'keeping safe around strangers.'

Whilst we do not wish to worry children, it is important that we educate them about being safe with strangers, especially as many of our older children walk home alone. It would be helpful if you could re-enforce the following messages at home:

- Never go anywhere on your own with a stranger
- Never get in a car with a stranger
- If a stranger offers you a present, say NO very loudly
- Remember to Yell, Run, Tell

On Tuesday year 4 had a hair-raising experience with a science workshop to extend our learning of electricity. We especially enjoyed using the Vann de Graff generator to investigate the effects of electric charge.
