WHO?



Hans Holbein

1497-1543

A German painter who lived at Henry VIII's court for periods.



HENRY VIII

1509 - 1547

Married six times and formed the Church of England.



Anne Boleyn

1501-1536

The second wife of Henry VIII and the mother of Elizabeth I.



ELIZABETH I

1558—1603

Daughter of Henry VIII & Anne Boleyn. She ruled England from 1558-1603.

KEY VOCABULARY



AUTHORITY: The power or right to give orders and make decisions.



PORTRAIT: A painting of a person showing at least the head and shoulders.



EVIDENCE An available group of facts to show whether something is true.



PROGRESS: To move forwards towards a destination.



HEIR A person who will inherit the wealth or position of a family member when they die.



PROPAGANDA: Information that is biased or misleading.



INVENTORY A list of all the items that a person or company owns.



TYRANT A cruel ruler.
