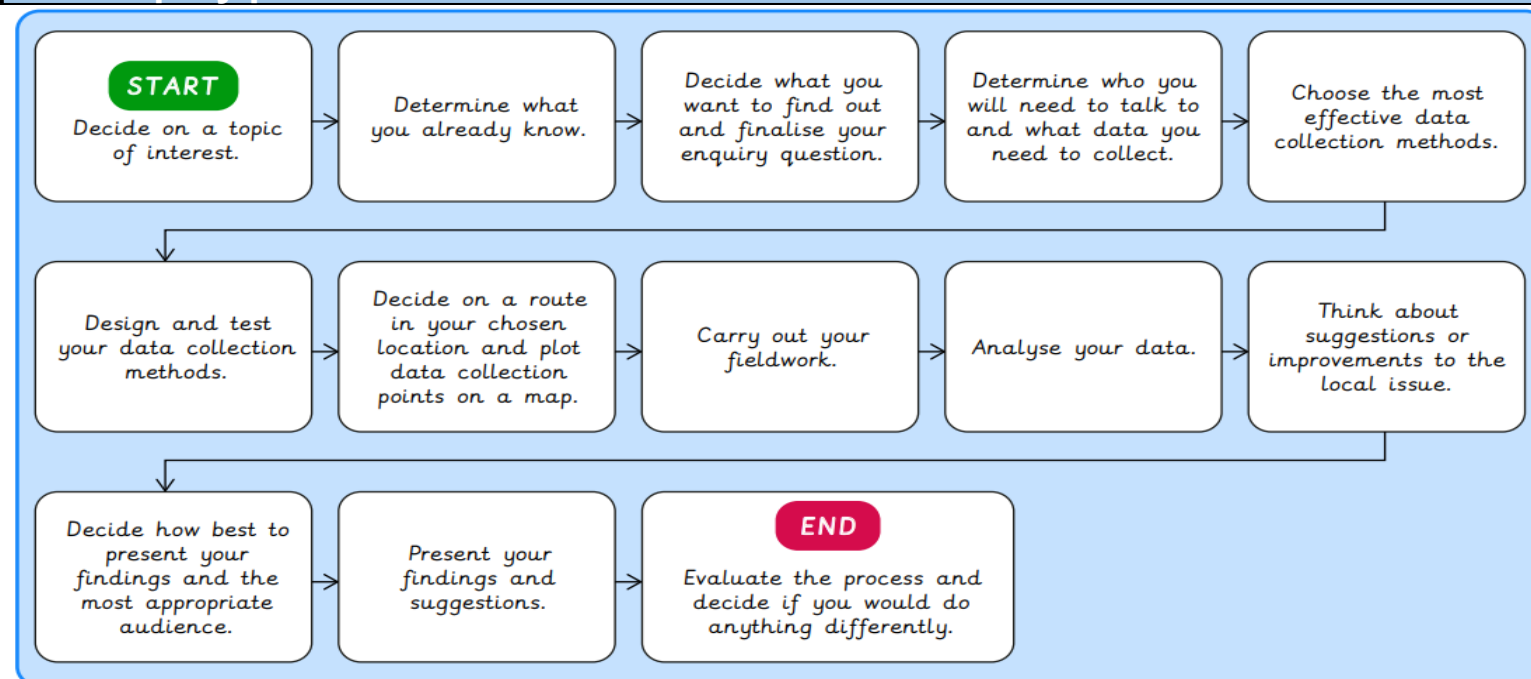










## Year 6: Can I carry out an independent field enquiry?

**Issue** : an important topic for discussion



**Justify** : .to show or prove something to be right or reasonable.



**Region** : an area of land that has common features.



**Subjective** : based on or influenced by personal feelings, tastes, or opinions.
