KEY VOCABULARY:



Atmosphere: The mood that a piece of artwork creates. (joyful, spooky, sad)



Concept: This is the idea behind any piece of artwork.



Location: This is the place where the artwork will be positioned.



Scale: The size of the artwork.



Viewer: The person who looks at and experiences the art.



Performance Art: Artwork created by the actions of an artist.
