**HATCHLANDS** close behind with **12,514**.



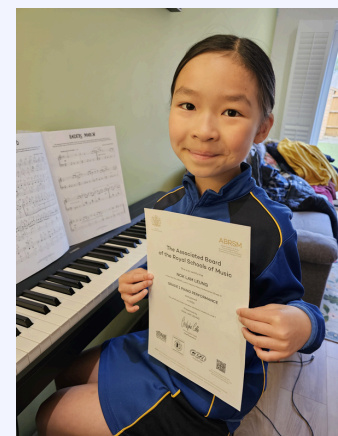
