HATCHLANDS finished with a respectable 14,476.

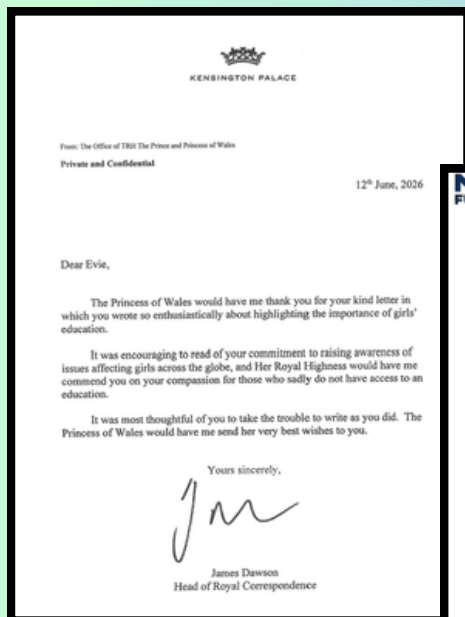
Leavers' fete
